## What is Legionella disease



Legionnaires' disease, is a kind of lung infection. It is caused by tiny germs called Legionella.

These germs like to live in water, such as in pipes or air conditioning in big buildings.

People can get sick if they breathe in small water droplets with these germs. Signs that someone is sick include coughing, having a fever, feeling cold and shaky, and having sore muscles. This illness can be very serious, especially for older people or those who are already sick.

Keeping water systems clean can stop the germs from spreading.

## How to keep your home safe



Run taps and showers at least once a week.



Keep taps and showeheads clean.



Vert Housing will do a Legionella Risk Assessment and water test every two years.



Your water should not be too hot, if it is, please tell your support staff immediately.
